GENERAL: By entering the event all acknowledge and agree that they shall comply with the WTT rules, regulations, policies and additional requirements and procedures as issued by WTT.

COVID-19 Protocols:

The [WTT Covid-19 Protocols](http://www.wtt.com) will apply, in addition to the basic information listed here.

- All participants, other than players, will be required to be fully vaccinated with a Covid-19 vaccination when attending this WTT event.
- Unvaccinated players must complete a Self-Administered Antigen Rapid Test (ART) within 24 hours of travel to the event as per COVID Protocols. Others as per the protocols.
- Where required in the Covid-19 Protocols results and/or photos of the Self-Administered ART showing date and time of the test written on the test kit must be submitted, in English, via upload to the Player/Participants individual profile on the Online Entry System (OES) if available AND to the Event Supervisor, and where applicable to any other location specified in the respective Event Prospectus.
- Please check the host country border entry requirements to confirm if you require additional ART or PCR test(s) depending from where you are travelling.
- Where on arrival and subsequent testing is required the charge for these will be **(USD 20 per test)**.
- Pre-departure PCR test **(USD 85)** or Pre-Departure ART test **(USD 20)** are paid by the participants and must be pre-booked.
- In case of a Covid-19 positive case, the Covid-19 Positive Case Management comes in effect and all costs including quarantine, ART/PCR tests or hospitality (accommodation, transportation, catering) shall be borne by the participant testing positive for Covid-19.
- Participant will additionally have to follow the local regulations valid at the time around isolation and positive case management.

ENTRY RESTRICTIONS & CANCELLATION PENALTIES

Top 20 Participation Restrictions

Singles events

- A maximum of three (3) players will be permitted to participate if players are inside the Top 20 of the ITTF TTWR, at the time of the entry deadline.

National Entry Restriction (NER)

Singles events

- Each Member Association shall be allowed a maximum of four (4) players per event excluding host wildcards and WTT nominations. The restriction is applied across both the Main Draw and Qualifying competition to provide for a maximum total of four (4) players in any combination (i.e., 2 Qualifying / 2 Main Draw or 1 Qualifying / 3 Main Draw).

Doubles events

- Each Member Association shall be allowed a maximum of eight (8) players per event but only three (3) full pair consisting of players from the same Member Association (i.e., 3 CHN/CHN, 1 CHN/AUS, 1 CHN/GER). The Host is permitted to use its wildcards to nominate additional players full or half pairs outside of the NER limit.

Mixed Doubles events

- Each Member Association shall be allowed a maximum of four (4) players per event in any pairing combination. The Host is permitted to use its wildcards to nominate additional players full or half pairs outside of the NER limit.

Where a Qualifying competition is undersubscribed additional players from Member Associations will be accepted into the Qualifying, based on the ITTF TTWR at the entries deadline to fill the available spots.

Wildcards

- The host is entitled to the following Wildcards: three (3) players for the Singles Main Draw, two (2) pairs for the Doubles Main Draw and two (2) pairs for Mixed Doubles Main Draw.
- The host is entitled to the following Wildcards for Qualifying: Six (6) players for Singles 48-Draw, eight (8) players for Singles 64-Draw, twelve (12) players for Singles 96-Draw, two (2) pairs for Doubles 16-Draw, four (4) pairs for Doubles 32-Draw, one (1) pair for Mixed Doubles 8-Draw, and two (2) pairs for Mixed Doubles 16-Draw.
- WTT reserves the right to use one (1) WTT Nomination for the Singles Main Draw.
- Any unused Host Wildcards/WTT Nominations will be returned to the direct entries.

Cancellation Penalties: Cancellations penalties as per the WTT Handbook will apply.
